The impact of agricultural growth on poiesty reduction in low income countries is far grater than any other sector. The organizing ranework of Dumon fearth centers on the distinction between the "growth" and the "participation" effects on powery of raising sectoral productivity. The participation effect of agricultural growth on headcount poverty is estimated to be on average 2.5 times larger than that of the service sector—over 4 times larger in 50th-Shahara Africa. In addition, the lower direct growth effect of agriculture is usually compensated by its targer contribution to growth in other sectors, especially in the low-income countries. Policymakers concerned with reducing poverty must seek to restore the fortunes of this much-neglected sector.
